RE: ZONING AMENDMENT

The members of Council, Township of East Hawkesbury, held a **Public Meeting** on Monday, August 13th, 2012 at 8:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber at St-Eugène.

1. The meeting is declared open at 8:00 p.m. by the Chairman
2. As required under the Planning Act, the Clerk then makes the following public statements:

"If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of East Hawkesbury before the by-law is passed, the person or public or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Township of East Hawkesbury to the Ontario Municipal Board also, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so."

3. At the request of the Chairman, the Clerk then explains the purpose and reasons for the proposed amendment, and copies of proposed amendment are available to the public.

4. The Chairman explains that this meeting is held to discuss a proposed amendment to the Township of East Hawkesbury Zoning By-Law No. 92-50 to modify the zoning on Part E1/2 of Lot 32, Concession 3 from Agriculture (A) to Agricultural-Restricted Residential (A-XR) in order to prohibit the development of residential uses on a newly created agricultural lot.

5. The Chairman then asks if anyone present wishes to make an oral written objection on the purposed amendment.

No comments are received from those present.
